INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT: Read carefully

- 1. Scholarships are for incoming first year undergraduate students (e.g. graduating High School Seniors, first time college students, etc.)
- 2. Students applying for a Mt. Hood scholarship to a college or university must complete this application.
- 3. The entire application must be typewritten or computer generated and double-spaced.
- 4. All students must submit a goal statement of no less than 500 words. Include comments on your career goals, and how you hope to serve our community or society in general.
- 5. Submit 3 letters of recommendation. Those from academic references, employers, religious leaders, and Masonic friends or relatives are preferred.
- 6. Submit an official sealed grade transcript *through the last quarter/semester completed*. Transcripts must be original. Students must have cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or equivalent scholastic standing to qualify for a scholarship.

Failure to furnish all required material, including your address, transcripts indicating a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or equivalent, three letters of recommendation and your personal essay by MAY 31 WILL DISQUALIFY the applicant.
